ACCESSIBLE ENTRY QUEUE

All our entrances are accessible and step-free. We have an accessible queueing lane at the event entrance for visitors who may require fast track entry.

The accessibility entrance queue at Taste of London follows a park path. Guests are not required to go on grass in order to enter the event.

However once inside the event there are areas of grass that customers must go through.

TRAKWAY

The event is on grass, however there is a path formed with metal Trakway throughout the event.

We are working to make Taste of London as accessible as possible. However, Taste of London is an outdoor event within a park that could pose problems for mobility (particularly in wet weather).









TOILETS

There are 3 accessible toilets at Taste of London. Please see our Event Map to for exact locations. Each toilet has a ramp to enter.

We also have one Changing Places / HDU located in the West Toilet Block. This is on the left-hand-side after entry.









RESTAURANTS AND BARS













Restaurants and bars are accessible via ramps, as shown on the left.

However, please note that some of these have a second floor, which are only accessible through steps, as depicted on the right.







VIP/CORPORATE HOSPITALITY AREA

The VIP area entrance and exit paths are covered with rubber matting and outdoor rugs.

Inside is mainly grass, and there is a range of seating around the VIP area.
